The Catholic Bishops of England and Wales have made an announcement on the "Sunday Obligation":

"The pressing challenges of the pandemic have lessened significantly. Most people have resumed the wide range of normal activities, no longer restricted by the previous Covid measures. We therefore believe that the reasons which have prevented Catholics from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation no longer apply. "We understand there will still be some members of our congregations who, for reasons of health, do not feel safe enough to return to Mass. It has always been the understanding of the Church that when the freedom of any Catholic to attend Mass in person is impeded for a serious reason, because of situations such as ill health, care for the sick or legitimate fear, this is not a breach of the Sunday Obligation."

Healing Voices Choir Concert on Sunday 10th July at 4.00pm at St Austin's. Under the musical direction of Jo Burrowes and accompanied by Fr Simon, the choir will perform a selection of songs from popular shows and other genres. The choir, who are based in Stafford, aim to inspire and support people affected by cancer and enjoy singing to audiences in the local area.
